- Helping the industry to attract, retain and develop people in a consistent manner









Context

lifecycle 10-30 years






OCP CFOPS Delivery model

Case Studies: Value of using OCP CFOPS

Operations of primary site (Swedbank)

Results achieved

- Fixed fee including all base services and assets (incl. lifecycle costs and asset risks) for 10+ years
- Fully based on availability SLAs (Power / ASHRAE)
- Compliance driven delivery organization in accordance with financial regulations as well as best practices and standards
- Transition, including the design and build of the data center was completed in 9 months

Operations Transition of multiple global sites (Global ICT company)

Results achieved

- Lowered cost for Site Management of five sites in two cities
- Reduced risks in operating model with improved processes and documentation
- Transition planning completed in 4 weeks
- Transition execution completed in 3 months
- Former employees transferred to Supplier
